



## DAILY INCIDENT REPORT

April 2, 2024

### Incidents

**Double Homicide Investigation** – On April 2 at 5:12AM, officers responded to the Westgate Apartments and Townhomes located in the 8100 block of Porters Ridge Ln in Manassas (20109) to investigate a shooting. The investigation revealed two adult women were found inside the residence by police during a welfare check, both appearing to have been shot. Both victims were pronounced dead on the scene. A person of interest has been detained in Shenandoah County who is presumed to be connected to the incident. The parties involved are believed to be known to one another, and the incident does not appear to be random. No charges have been obtained at this time. Detectives are actively investigating the incident to determine what led up to the shooting and are seeking to speak with anyone who has information to aid in the investigation. The identities of the two deceased will be released pending notifications of a next-of-kin. More information will be released as it becomes available. The investigation continues.

**Armed Robbery** – On April 1 at 1:29PM, officers responded to investigate a robbery that was reported to have occurred in the 7800 block of Brookview Ct. in Manassas (20109) earlier that morning at approximately 2:00AM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 17-year-old male juvenile, was meeting a female acquaintance in the above area when two men entered their vehicle. During the encounter, the victim was struck by both men and the female acquaintance before one of the men retrieved a firearm. The victim was physically struck with the firearm, rendering him temporarily unconscious. Later that morning, the victim woke inside the vehicle and went to an area hospital where police were contacted. A phone and purse were reported missing. **Preliminarily, the incident does not appear to be random.**
