## ***Dining with Diabetes*** ***A Program for People with Diabetes and Their Families***

### **Diabetes Lifestyle Management - Goals for the Class Include:**

- Increase knowledge of healthy food choices for families with diabetes or other chronic diseases
- Demonstrate healthy cooking techniques
- Promote physical activity as a part of diabetes control
- Encourage self-management with opportunities to share and learn from one another

### **This course is for:**

People with diabetes and their family members, caregivers and support persons can enroll in *Dining with Diabetes*

### **There are four two hour lessons and a follow-up meeting**

### **The four lessons include:**

- On the Road to Living Well with Diabetes
- Carbohydrates and Sweeteners
- Fats and Sodium
- Vitamins, Minerals, and Fiber

**Follow-up meeting three months after the class is over to see how everyone is doing, answer questions and enjoy a guest speaker.**

### **Course fees include notebook of information and recipes**

- \$40/ person with diabetes (includes A1c test at first class and follow-up)
  - \$15/ spouse, family member, case-worker or caregiver
- \*\*Class size limited to 20 students\*\***

**The A1c tests at the first and follow-up classes and a light meal at each class are included in the registration fee.**
