April 2008 - Please be extra vigilant when coming into the Senior Center from the West Courthouse Road direction, due to construction in the area. Use extra care when driving to the Senior Center, and plan extra time. Please use CAUTION!

From I-66 west towards Manassas:

Take the first Manassas exit, Route 28 South. Follow Route 28 south through Manassas Park, then into the Old Towne area of Manassas. You will be on Route 28 south through the Old Towne area (Route 28 becomes Church Street in Old Towne Manassas). After you've come through the Old Towne area, there will be signs for Route 234 (also known as Grant Avenue). Turn right at the stop light onto Grant Avenue, and take the second left onto Mosby Street (a one way street at this point). Go one block and cross Peabody Street. At the corner of Mosby and Peabody, you'll see Prince William County signage directing you one block straight ahead to the senior center. The senior center is the only building on the right side road, just past an area marked for public and courthouse parking. The senior center is a one story red brick building with a single flag pole in front.

From Route 15 and Route 66 east towards Washington, D.C.

Follow Route 15 to Route 66 East. Take the second exit, Exit 44, Manassas Route 234. The expressway ends at Route 28. Go north on Route 28 into Manassas. Pass Godwin Drive and Wellington Road. Continue on Route 28 past the railroad tracks and the third light at Stonewall Road. Proceed to your next left, West Courthouse Road. (The new Social Security office building will be on your right when you make the turn). Turn right at the stop sign. Make the first left into the Senior Center parking lot. The senior center is a one story red brick building with a single flag pole in front.

From Prince William Parkway

On Prince William Parkway, go west towards Manassas. As you cross Liberia Avenue, the Parkway becomes Fairview Avenue. Follow Fairview Avenue as it curves to the right. At the next light, Fairview Avenue becomes Richmond Avenue (Metz Jr. High School will be on your left). Continue on Richmond Avenue to Grant Avenue (also known as Route 234 and Dumfries Road). Turn right onto Grant Ave. Go under the railroad bridge, cross Center Street, Church Street, and Lee Avenue. Take the next left onto Mosby Street, a one way street at this point. Go one block and cross Peabody Street. At the corner of Mosby and Peabody, you'll see Prince William County signage directing you one block straight ahead to the senior center. The senior center is the only building on the right side road, just past an area marked for public and courthouse parking. The senior center is a one story red brick building with a single flag pole in front.
