

## OFFICIAL ELECTION RESULTS -- NOVEMBER 7, 2006 SPECIAL ELECTION

### Proposed Constitutional Amendments

**Proposed Constitutional Amendment #1 (Marriage)** – shall Article 1 (the Bill of Rights) of the Constitution of Virginia be amended to state: “That only a union between one man and one woman may be a marriage valid in or recognized by this Commonwealth and its political subdivisions. This Commonwealth and its political subdivisions shall not create or recognize a legal status for relationships of unmarried individuals that intends to approximate the design, qualities, significance, or effects of marriage. Nor shall this Commonwealth or its political subdivisions create or recognize another union, partnership, or other legal status to which is assigned the rights, benefits, obligations, qualities, or effects of marriage”?

**Passed: Total Statewide votes: YES 1,328,537 to NO 999,687**

**Proposed Constitutional Amendment #2 (Powers of the General Assembly; Limitations)** – Shall Section 14 of Article IV of the Constitution of Virginia be amended by deleting the provision that prohibits the incorporation of churches a provision that was ruled to be unconstitutional and therefore now is obsolete?

**Passed: Total Statewide votes: YES 1,426,248 to NO 761,632**

**Proposed Constitutional Amendment #3 (Exempt Property)** – Shall Section 6 of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia be amended to authorize legislation to permit localities to provide a partial exemption from real property taxes for real estate with new structures and improvements in conservation, redevelopment, or rehabilitation areas?

**Passed: Total Statewide votes: YES 1,425,143 to NO 775,328**

### Prince William County Bond Referendums

**Road Improvement Bonds:** Shall Prince William County, Virginia, contract a debt and issue its general obligation capital improvement bonds in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$300,000,000 for the purpose of paying the costs of acquisition, designing, constructing, and improving Route 1, Route 28, Minnieville Road, Heathcote Boulevard, Prince William Parkway, University Boulevard, Rollins Ford Road, Old Carolina Road, and Countywide road safety improvements?

**Passed: Total votes: YES 70,565 to NO 15,594**

**Library Improvement Bonds:** Shall Prince William County, Virginia, contract a debt and issue its general obligation capital improvement bonds in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$42,550,000 for the purpose of paying the costs of acquisition, design, construction, and improvement of two libraries, one in the Dumfries area and the other in the Gainesville area?

**Passed: Total votes: YES 61,966 to NO 23,967**

**Park Improvement Bonds:** Shall Prince William County, Virginia, contract a debt and issue its general obligation capital improvement bonds in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$27,000,000 for the purpose of paying the cost to provide park improvements including the acquisition, construction, development, and equipping of park facilities in the County?

**Passed: Total votes: YES 65,288 to NO 20,680**
