Alexis (Lexie) Glover's Case

On January 7, 2009, at approximately 11:15 AM the Prince William County Police Department received a call regarding a missing 13 year old girl, Alexis Glover. An extensive search was launched that included approximately 300 law enforcement officers at different times throughout the investigation.

A Child is Missing- Reverse call system

On Friday January 9th at approximately 12:35PM, we received a call from a citizen reporting that he found the body of a child in a shallow creek near the intersection of Asdee Lane and Greatbridge Road in Woodbridge, Virginia. The evidence indicates that the child's body was placed in the area where it was found on or about the date she was reported missing.

On January 13, 2009 at approximately 10:00 PM, Prince William County Police arrested Alfreedia Leona Gregg-Glover, 44 years of age of 8245 Sunset Drive Manassas, VA. She has been charged with Felony Child Neglect, a class 4 Felony that carries a penalty of 2-10 years in prison and Filing a False Police Report., a class 1 misdemeanor which carries up to 1 year in jail and up to a \$2500 fine.

Gregg-Glover is being held without bond. The court date for Filing a False Police report is 2/23/09 in the General District Court and the Child Neglect charge will be 3/4/09 in Juvenile and Domestic Relations Court.

The cause of death is still pending. The investigation continues.
