RESERVATIONS

Reservations commence on the date listed under each tour destination in this schedule. **On that date, reservations are accepted by telephone only at 703-792-6400, beginning at 8:00 a.m. No reservations will be taken before the reservation date begins.** On reservation day, reservations can be made for up to four people per phone call. Reservations will continue to be taken after that date until the listed final reservation date, or until the tour is full. A scheduled tour must have the minimum number of participants required to run; the minimum number varies depending on the tour. All tours in this schedule will take place on a charter bus provided by an independent contractor apart from Prince William County.

If spaces remain open 3 days after the reservation date, residents over 18 years of age of the tri-jurisdictional area, and from neighboring counties may participate. Those participants from neighboring counties will be charged \$5.00 additional for a day trip, and \$10.00 for an overnight trip. To ensure a reservation, all admission and/or bus fares **must be paid in full 14 days after the reservation date** or your reservation will be cancelled. BLUEBIRD POLICY MANUAL

The current BLUEBIRD POLICY MANUAL is available on line at www.pwcgov.org/aoa and at the Woodbridge and Manassas Senior Centers. It is your responsibility to make yourself aware of important information concerning your Bluebird experience.

PAYMENT POLICY

Payments for trips are due within two weeks of the reservation date; check, exact cash or money order is accepted. If you do not make your payment within those two weeks, your name will be dropped from the reservation list. No notice is required to be given from the Tour Coordinator if your name is dropped from the reservation list if no payment has been made.

REFUND POLICY

A refund will only be given if there is someone on the "standby list" to take your space, or in the event that the Tour Coordinator can secure a full refund from the vendor.

CANCELLATIONS

In the event that you need to cancel your reservation, please call the Agency on Aging Office and speak with the Tour Coordinator. All cancellations are subject to an administrative fee of \$5.00 for day trips and \$10.00 for overnight trips. The Bluebird Tour Program highly suggests Trip Cancellation Insurance for the longer, more costly trips.

SEATING

On Day-Tours, the participants who board in Manassas will sit on the left side of the coach behind the bus driver. Participants who board in Woodbridge sit on the right side of the coach. This policy is in place to assure front of the coach seating for both departure locations. On overnight tours, a seating chart will be mailed to each participant along with the itinerary for the overnight tour.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

If Prince William County Schools are closed due to inclement weather, tours will be cancelled unless otherwise stated in the schedule. If school is not in session, tours are also cancelled when Prince William County Government employees have "Unscheduled Leave" due to inclement weather. For notification of cancelled tours on holidays and weekends, call **(703) 792-RIDE (7433)** for a recorded message up to two hours before the tour is to depart from the first pick-up location. **It is the participant's responsibility to call the Bluebird Travel Hotline to find out if a tour has been cancelled due to inclement weather.** If money has been paid out to a vendor for a tour that has been cancelled due to inclement weather, a refund will only be given if the Tour Coordinator can secure a refund from the vendor or if money has not already been paid out. Attempts are made to reschedule a tour when it is cancelled due to inclement weather. If a tour can be rescheduled and an individual is unable to participate in the new date, a refund will only be given if there is a refund secured from the vendor or there is someone on the standby list to take the seat.

In the event that there is inclement weather while a tour is taking place and additional day(s)/night(s) on the road are necessary, the cost of the lodging and meals will be at the expense of the participants. It is at the discretion of the Tour Escort and/or Driver to decide when a tour will be postponed due to inclement weather while a tour is taking place.
