Four Are Arrested in Stolen Guns Case

PRINCE WILLIAM COUNTY, VIRGINIA . . . Sometime during the early morning hours of Sunday, May 31st, two guns (one rifle, one handgun), a bullet-proof vest and a gun belt were stolen from a law enforcement officer's car.

The incident occurred on Fern Oak Court in the Manassas area. Three other cars in the neighborhood were entered. An iPod was taken from one of the three cars. It is unknown how entry was gained into the cars.

During the investigation, police received information that the stolen weapons might be located at one or more residences on Grant Avenue in Manassas. Searches were conducted at several residences but the weapons were not located.

However, Prince William County Detectives Craig Cunningham and Saemi Kitchens arrested the following four people in connection with the case on June 5th:



Rick Bosch, 21, of 9009 Sandalwood Drive, #A, in Manassas – charged with two counts of Grand Larceny and one count of Larceny With Intent to Sell. He is being held on no bond and has a court date of July 13, 2009.



Amanda Lloyd, 21 of 8900 Wood Drift Circle, #101 in Manassas – charged with two counts of Grand Larceny. She is being held on a \$5,000 bond and has a court date of July 13, 2009.
