One day tours must have a minimum of twenty persons to run and an overnight tour must have a minimum of thirty persons to run. All tours will take place on a Quality Tour Transport motor coach.

Three (3) days after the initial reservation date, remaining space will be open to residents over 18 years of age as well as groups from Prince William County as well as all neighboring counties. To ensure a reservation, all admission and/or bus fares must be paid in full 14 days after the reservation date or your reservation will be cancelled. Payment Policy

Payments for trips are due within two weeks of the reservation date; check, exact cash, money order or credit card is accepted.
