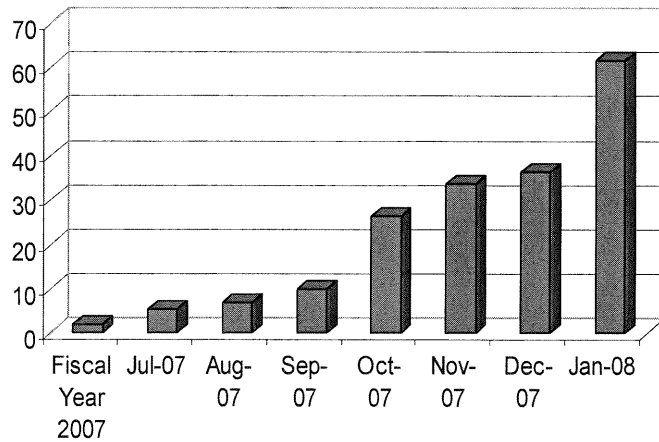

Total	\$1,362,500

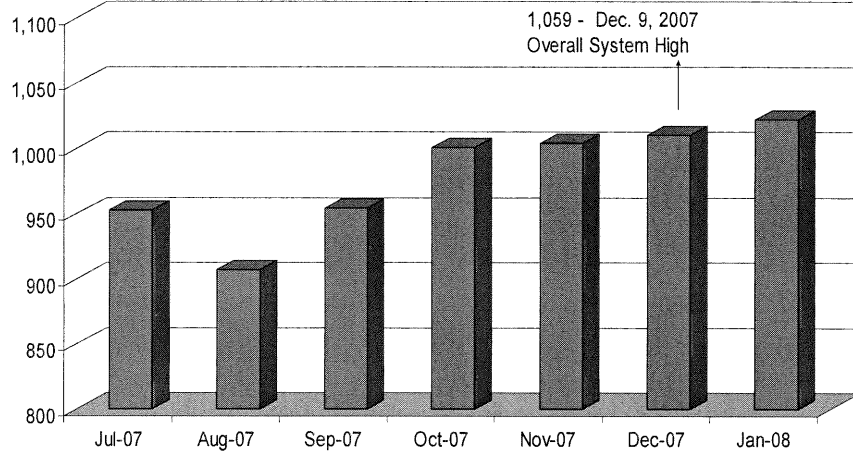
- Direct Costs include food, clothing, medical, etc. at \$15/day
