Opioids, Naloxone Education and Overdose Reversal Training

Did you know.....

- Opioid overdoses continue to increase in our community?
- The only way to reverse an opioid overdose is to administer NALOXONE?
- You can be trained to administer this life-saving medication?

REVIVE! training will provide you with the knowledge, skills and tools to administer naloxone to prevent overdose deaths. Participants will also learn about opiates, opioid addiction, types of naloxone, and rescue breathing.



Each attendee also receives a free REVIVE! kit, which includes supplies needed in an overdose situation.

Prince William County Community Services has partnered with the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services, the Prevention Alliance of Greater Prince William and the Chris Atwood Foundation to provide the REVIVE! trainings in our community.

This ninety minute REVIVE! training is **free and open to everyone.**
If you or someone you know uses opioids, PLEASE ATTEND!

We are unable to provide no-cost Narcan at this time-but will provide information on how to get it.
