What is HPP?

The Homeless Prevention Program (HPP) is a state-funded program for the prevention of homelessness in Virginia. The program is designed to divert households from homelessness by providing targeted and limited assistance to households who are likely to otherwise become homeless.

The program goal is to provide effective and efficient assistance to prevent new cases of homelessness. The program is a community-based resource that maximizes mainstream resources and prevents households from becoming homeless.

Who Qualifies for HPP?

- The household must be **below 50 percent of Area Median Income** (AMI) with no more than \$500 in assets (includes all checking, savings, retirement accounts, stocks, bonds, mutual funds, and real estate).
- The household must be at risk of losing its housing, with no adequate housing options, and significant risk factors .
