The Family Loan Partnership provides interest free-loans to families in Northern Virginia making the transition from Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) to independence. Qualified applicants receive up to \$3,000 and will be expected to pay the loan back within 24 months. The two main criteria for applicant eligibility is: 1) TANF or TANF transitional (must have received a TANF check within the past 12 months) AND 2) Must be employed for at least 90 days.

Office is responsible for administering County Housing Programs and initiatives such as

Community Development and Rehabilitation for owner-occupied units or first time home buyers; **First Time Homebuyers Program** (FTHB) provides financial counseling, education, and deferred loans for down-payment, closing costs or energy efficiency improvements for the property being purchased; **Housing Choice Voucher Program** (Section 8), and **Transitional Housing program**, referrals for transitional housing program required from an area homeless shelter.
