The Family Loan Partnership provides interest free-loans to families in Northern Virginia making the transition from Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) to independence. Qualified applicants receive up to \$3,000 and will be expected to pay the loanback within 24 months. The two main criteria for applicant eligibility is:

- 1) TANF or TANF transitional (must have received a TANF check within the past 12 months),
- 2) Must be employed for at least 90 days.
