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| <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Prospective volunteers must be 12 years or older or have completed 6th grade. You must enjoy working with the public and must have at least a 6th grade reading ability. 2. Volunteers will be assigned a minimum of 2 hours at Bull Run, Central, Chinn Park, or Potomac, and 2-3 hours at the neighborhood libraries. Volunteers are required to work for at least 8 weeks between June 16 and August 29. 3. Volunteers must notify their library or the supervisors of any absences, such as camps or family vacations, as far in advance as possible. | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. Two occasions of tardiness or absence not prearranged and any behavioral problems are grounds for possible dismissal from the program. 5. Those accepted into the program must attend a training session. 6. Direct any questions to the Children's staff at your local library or to the Volunteer Coordinator. 7. Any Block (i.e., fines over \$20.00) or lost items on your borrowing record must be cleared before acceptance into the program. |
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
