Permission is hereby granted to the above utility company insofar as Prince William County has the right and power to grant the same to perform the construction as shown on the approved utility installation plan(s). Said work will be completed in a manner satisfactory to Prince William County by:

Prince William County reserves full governmental control over the subject matter of this utility permit. Utilities shall be installed underground in accordance with standards of utility practice for underground construction, and in accordance with standards furnished to and regulations issued by any applicable regulatory authority. Such standards and any amendments thereto, shall be furnished to the county by the utility company, and shall comport with the guidelines specified in the land use permit manual of the Virginia Department of Transportation, Section 3.200 titled "Guidelines for the Accommodation of the Utility Facilities within the Right-of-Way of Highways." Utility line installation is expected to conform to all the regulations of the Federal Occupational Safety and Health Administration and the Virginia Safety and Health Codes Commission. Should the utility company deviate from the approved plans, without prior approval from Prince William County, this permit shall be considered void and of no effect.

The signatures at the bottom of this permit, indicating approval of the installed erosion control devices by the Environmental Services Division Site Inspector, are required before proceeding with land disturbing (construction) activities. This permit shall be considered null and void if this requirement is not met. All erosion control devices, inclusive of dust control, must be satisfactorily maintained until the final release of the siltation and erosion control escrow. Mud tracking out of the project site is prohibited.

Application is hereby made for a permit as indicated above and shown on the accompanying plan or sketch. Said work will be done in compliance with the provisions, rules, and regulations of the Virginia Department of Transportation, Virginia Erosion Control Law, the Code of Prince William County, the State Corporation Commission of Virginia, the Office of Pipeline Safety of the U.S Department of Transportation, or the U.S Department of Labor, so far as said rules are applicable thereto. Upon completion of construction applicant agrees to maintain all improvements as imposed by the above described entities.

For utility installation in subdivisions where the streets are not yet in the state system, the utility company shall secure approval for access and construction from the developer (Prince William County Design and Construction Standards Manual).

If work is performed in an existing State right-of-way, (road that has been assigned a route number and is maintained by the state), a separate permit is required from the Virginia Department of Transportation. This permit does not authorize construction within privately owned right-of-way or property.

The owner must notify Department of Public Works, Environmental Services Division at 703-792-7070 at least 24 hours prior to the start of construction with applicable County ordinances and policies.
