TRAVIS' RACE TRAINING TIP - STRONGER LEGS = MORE SPEED

How do you develop leg muscles to make you run faster? I recommend focusing on the key muscle groups involved in running, such as quadriceps, hamstrings, and glutes. Strengthening these key muscle groups will allow you to begin seeing immediate results as you run faster than you ever have before! But I'll let you in on a little secret - sprinters work extremely hard to develop the muscles that help them run faster.

Exercises to help strengthen your legs include: squats, lunges, step ups, box jumps, and jump rope.
