Prepare Sharps for Proper Disposal

- ◆ Place used, recapped syringes in a rigid plastic container with a screw on lid (like a detergent bottle).
- ◆ Make sure the container is recapped tightly.
- ◆ Clearly label the container "Do Not Recycle".

Landfill Drop Off

- ◆ You must bring your container to the Prince William County Landfill.
(These items are NOT accepted at the Balls Ford Road facility.)
- ◆ Tell the clerk you have sharps for disposal.
- ◆ There is a yellow container for sharps at the checkpoint.
- ◆ The clerk will direct you to drop your sharps into the container. The clerk is not allowed to handle sharps.
