Key Operational Updates:

- Governor Northam will not renew the COVID-19 state of emergency when it expires on June 30. All remaining public health restrictions will end; however, those who wish to wear masks and those who aren't vaccinated are encouraged to continue wearing masks. PWC Local Declaration of Emergency will remain in effect until further notice due to ongoing County and PWHD response and recovery needs.
- As of June 24th, 60 homebound individuals have been fully vaccinated through PWHD's homebound program. Email PWHDPR@vdh.virginia.gov or call 1-877-VAX-IN-VA to be put on the list.
 - For each person, provide: name, DOB, address, vaccine preference, email and any comments.

- PWHD considers homebound patients to be those that cannot leave the house for a healthcare-related encounter without assistance of two or more people.
- The last day of Community Vaccination Center operations at the old Gander Mountain store was June 26. For anyone needing a second dose, please visit vaccinate.virginia.gov to schedule an appointment.
- CDC Director Dr. Rochelle Walensky has signed an extension to the eviction moratorium further preventing the eviction of tenants who are unable to make rental payments until July 31, 2021. - Prince William County's labor market showed signs of continued improvement consistent with the county's overall economic recovery. In April 2021, the unemployment rate continued its downward trend, falling to 4.1% from 5.2% in March 2021 and a high of 11.4% in April 2020. Declines were also observed in initial and continued unemployment insurance claims.
