- VACCINE: Johnson & Johnson (for additional information on J&J visit <https://rb.gy/e7cxwh>) \*Patients are being made aware of the rare risk of blood clots, and can make appointments at other sites which have either the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine.
- Walk-ups may be available dependent on appointment availability.

Next week, May 4 and 5, the City of Manassas will hold a 2-day 2<sup>nd</sup> dose clinic at Metz Middle School for those who have already received their first dose of Pfizer at Metz Middle School on April 13 and 14.

To find your own COVID-19 vaccine appointments, go to [vaccinefinder.org](https://vaccinefinder.org). Then enter your **Zip Code**, and you want to select **25-miles** for the **Distance Range**. You have the ability to pick the vaccine type—Pfizer, Modera or Johnson and Johnson. You also get to select the day and time for your vaccine appointment.
