VACCINATED**

Pfizer is the only COVID-19 Vaccine Approved for Anyone 16 and Older

On Tuesday, May 4, the MAP Clinic will use the **Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine**. The clinic starts at 8 a.m., and the last appointment is expected to be at 2:30 p.m. The clinic is at the Manassas Park Community Center, [99 Adam Street](#).
*Clinic walk-up appointments are based on availability. *

What if you cannot make Tuesday's clinic?

Getting a vaccine appointment has gotten a whole lot easier with opportunities to select the vaccine you want; Pfizer, Moderna, or Johnson and Johnson.

1. Enter your zip code.



2. Select **25-miles** for the **Distance Range**.
3. Select your vaccine type.
