# Today Is National Black HIV/AIDS Awareness Day

Today is National Black HIV/AIDS Awareness Day, a day to acknowledge progress in HIV prevention and care among Black/African American people while recognizing the work still needed. To #StopHIVTogether, we must address #HIVstigma and barriers. <u>https://bit.ly/3r6BxM5</u> #NBHAAD.

Despite overall progress in reducing HIV transmission in the United States, <u>HIV</u> <u>continues to affect some groups</u> more than others due to longstanding and ingrained barriers. Black or African American (hereafter referred to as Black) people account for a higher proportion of new HIV infections, compared to other races and ethnicities. Black people accounted for 13% of the U.S. population but 40% of people with HIV in 2019, according to CDC estimates.

HIV disparities can and must end. Racism, longstanding systemic inequities, social and economic marginalization, residential segregation, <u>unequal reach of HIV prevention and treatment</u>, and higher levels of HIV in some communities are among the factors that have contributed to these troubling and persistent disparities.
