### The Prince William Health District What You Should Know

[VDH Mask page](#) – As of March 23, 2022, the Virginia Standard for Infectious Disease Prevention of the SARS-CoV-2 Virus That Causes COVID-19 (“Virginia Standard”) is no longer in effect.

Workplaces are encouraged to establish a COVID-19 mask policy that aligns with current CDC guidance.

#### Situations where you should always wear a mask:

- If you have [symptoms of COVID-19](#)
- If you are in the [10 days after a positive COVID-19 test](#) and around other people - [Isolation Calculator](#)
- If you are in the [10 days after an exposure to someone with COVID-19](#) and are around other people - [Quarantine Calculator](#)
