All decks that are greater than 16½ inches above the finished grade of the ground will require a plan review and building permit.

Decks that are 16½ inches or less above the finished grade are considered equivalent to an on-grade patio, and a building permit is only required if a roof and/or walls are being constructed on the deck or if the deck is supporting a hot tub.
