



## COVID-19 PROCEDURES AT PAT WHITE CENTER AT BEN LOMOND

Visitors, patrons and staff will be required to wear face coverings when entering/ exiting the building and while moving from one area to another. Social Distancing while inside the facility is highly encouraged.

**All staff and patrons will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms prior to admission to the facility.**

### Pre-Screening

Upon entry to the building patrons must receive a temperature check.

- **Anyone with a temperature over 100.4 degrees, anyone experiencing symptoms, will not be permitted into the facility.**

In addition to a temperature check, patrons and staff will be asked if they have any of the following:

- new cough that cannot be attributed to another health condition,
- new shortness of breath that cannot be attributed to another health condition,
- new chills that cannot be attributed to another health condition,
- new sore throat that cannot be attributed to another health condition,
- new muscle aches that cannot be attributed to another health condition or specific activity (such as physical exercise).

### Cleaning and Sanitizing Procedures

We ask patrons and staff to wash your hands. There will be several sanitizing stations throughout the facility for your convenience, when washing is not possible.

We've built in several disinfecting breaks into our facility schedule in order to reduce the risk for patrons and staff. Disinfection methods will include the use an EPA approved disinfectant solution. A full cleaning of each facility will occur every evening.

### Water Fountains

Water fountains are not available for use. Water bottle fillers are available.
